	(b) The issues discussed were as follows:	
	(i) Pedestrian crossings to the park and playground - The Council have agreed to put in pedestrian crossings at Orby Park/Orby Drive and Glencairn Drive to help safer crossing. The works should be completed by year-end.	For Info
	(ii) Traffic Management - The Council have agreed to review the traffic light sequencing to minimise build up of traffic trying to exit the estate. They will also conduct a traffic survey at peak times to gather data on the extent of the issue.	For Info
	(iii) Extension of pathway to link up with pedestrian way at Glencairn Luas stop - These works are expected to start soon opposite Glencairn View/Glencairn Garth. The issues in the corner of the green area should dissipate when access is in place for the new development.	For Info
	(iv) Playground facilities including CCTV - A refurbishment of the playground facilities will be carried out subject to funding approval. The addition of CCTV has been ruled out on "legal and logistical" grounds.	For Info
